Did You Know?

Some houses were produced with angled side walls, either on one side or both, and the angle could be inward or outward. These make it easy to change the angle of your overall scene.



Gault Houses Display Tips


There is no right way of wrong way to display your Gault Original houses, however whether your collection is comprised of just a few pieces or a more expansive set, here are some display tips that can enhance your scene.

Angles: positioning your houses at various angles often adds character and help the scene look more like a neighborhood rather than having all houses side-by-side in a straight line.



Height focus: if your collection includes houses of shorter and taller houses, it may be visually interesting to build height towards the center of the scene, placing the shorter houses on the ends and progressively increased the height as you reach the middle.

Elevations: naturally if your scene includes multiple rows of houses, the back rows should be elevated for better viewing, however sometimes even within a single row it can enhance the look of the scene to elevate part of it. This can be done with simple materials like a flat stone or tile, or by using the JCarlton pavement accessories that we sometime offer.



Finally, using a mirror as a base for your display can also serve as a great alternative way to show and enjoy your Gault houses.

Just have fun changing things around, you may be surprised how different your collection looks simply by swapping or repositioning the pieces!
