Gault houses are not of a precise model scale or replicas. They are artistic interpretations of either real or fictitious houses across various countries or regions.



Focus on a Unique Gault Piece: Château de Chenonceau

Jean-Pierre Gault and his artist team occasionally created unique pieces for personal enjoyment or for family and friends. In 2017, his brother Dominique shared a photo of such piece in his possession: the Château de Chenonceau.



This phenomenal French landmark (photo below) is located on the Cher river and was built in the 1500's. It also features formal gardens and is one of the most visited château in France.
