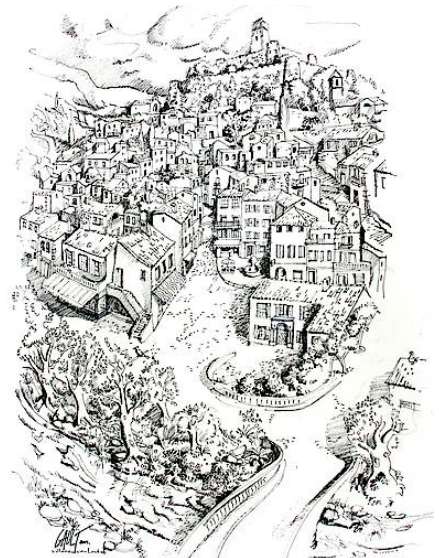

Jean-Pierre Gault was an avid artist focused on the art of paintings. Not surprisingly of course it was also highly skilled at drawing and creating sketches. He had a natural ability to portray perspective and distance. Here is an example of his drawings.

At the bottom left, you can see his classic Gault signature, as well as "Villeneuve-Loubet" which is the town in Provence where he lived. His brother Dominique still lives in the town and is involved in the community
